Numeracy - fractions/decimals/percentages, algebra, problem-solving



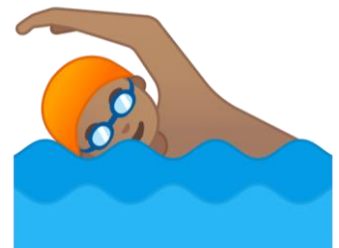
Winter Sport:

Team Awa Nui and Team Moana will continue their winter sport programme this term, competing on Friday afternoons in term three on 26 July and 9 August.
