## **Our Learning Programme**

### Inquiry/Science

On Wednesday 22 October, Te Kākano will take a field trip to the International Antarctic Centre. This relates to our inquiry theme: 'Habitats: Rocky Shore/Antarctica'. During our visit, we will follow the Education Programme: Challenges & Sustainability, looking at understanding the challenges facing environmental conservation in Antarctica and exploring sustainable options to address them. Learners will also get to visit the snow room and see some penguins.
