

#### Free Dental Care for Children

One of our Community Dental Service vans will shortly be visiting Russley. Do not be concerned if your child is not called for a check-up this time; only children who currently require a check will be seen at this visit. Dental therapists will provide a regular check-up and preventative care which may include cleaning/scaling to remove plague,

dental x-rays to check for decay, presence and position of teeth, fluoride varnish andfissure sealants, if required.

If your child requires any other dental care, they will bring home a 'Care Plan' which will explain what dental care and appointment times are required. Contact our Call Centre to arrange a time to take your child to a Community Clinic for this dental care.

Year 8 students enrolled with the Community Dental Service are transferred to a FREE private dentist from year 9 until their 18th birthday. Please ensure you have informed your child of their family dentist (not orthodontist). This will enable us to transfer your child onto the correct dentist for year 9 onwards. More information will be sent home after their year 8 check-up.


